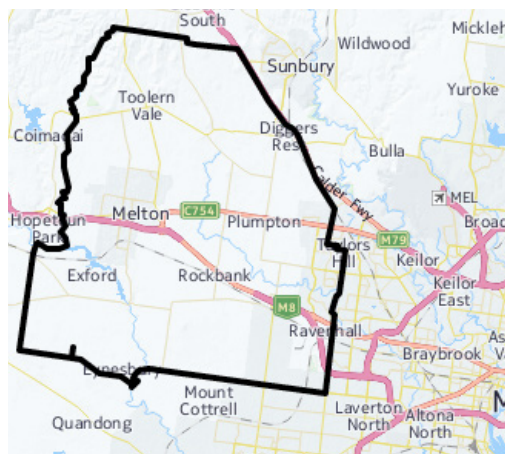

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Funding from the Growing Suburbs Fund will help Melton City Council build a new multi-purpose facility in Burnside Heights, which will provide a new home for the Caroline Springs Scout Group.

The new facility will include:

- A scout activity space with an education centre; and
- Communal facilities including meeting rooms, kitchen, offices, and amenities.

This new facility will improve the opportunities for young people to participate in community activities in this rapidly growing area.

MELTON CITY COUNCIL

The City of Melton is located approximately 40 kilometres west of Melbourne and has been experiencing significant growth over the past decade with new suburban developments such as Caroline Springs and Hillside.

Melton is expected to continue strong residential growth with a number of new growth areas currently under development. It is anticipated that Melton's population will more than double between 2016 and 2036¹.
