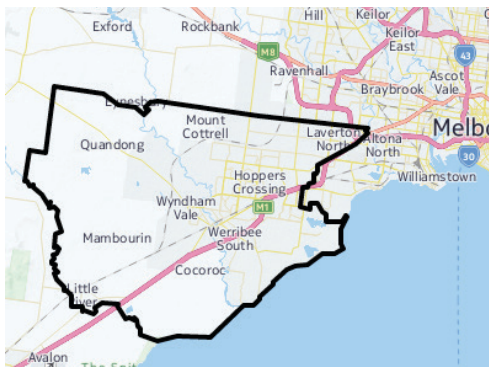

Wyndham is located on the south-western fringe of Melbourne with Werribee at its commercial heart. The city is a major horticultural area for Melbourne as well as a designated growth area, currently ranked the third fastest growing local government area in Victoria.¹

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Growing Suburbs Fund will help improve the opportunities for active and passive recreation for the Wyndham community, by delivering an integrated sports and community hub in Mossfiel Reserve in Hoppers Crossing.

The sports and community hub will include:

- A sports pavilion with a community space
- Upgraded sports pitches
- Addition of a third rugby pitch
- Upgraded playground facilities
- Upgraded lighting for extended use; and
- Walking and cycling paths.

Expected completion: Mid 2018

Growing Suburbs Fund: \$1,800,000
