TRUCK CURFEW EXEMPTIONS

The Victorian Government has lifted truck curfews across the state from 7 January 2022 to 7 April 2022.

This supports deliveries to Victorian pharmacies and supermarkets in light of impacts to workforce and supply chain due to COVID-19.

Heavy vehicles can pass time-based curfew “no trucks” signs when making grocery deliveries to supermarkets or personal hygiene products to retail outlets.

Heavy vehicles can also remain in loading zones for the time required to make these deliveries.

The National Heavy Vehicle Regulator is monitoring and enforcing compliance in curfew areas.

The Department of Transport continues to work with local government, communities and industry to ensure truck curfews are not enforced on Victorian roads during the exemption period.

The truck curfew exemption period will be reviewed in line with public health advice.
