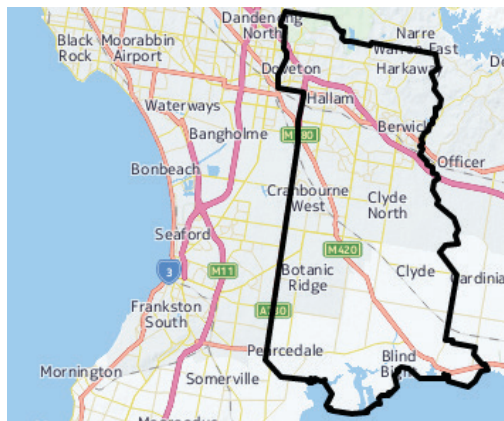

CITY OF CASEY

The City of Casey is located in Melbourne's south-eastern suburbs, between 28 and 60 kilometres south-east of the Melbourne GPO.

The City of Casey is a rapidly developing residential area, with large areas of land still allocated for urban development, and surrounding rural areas. The City of Casey encompasses a total land area of about 400 square kilometres. Rural land is used mainly for grazing, horse agistment, market gardening, flower growing and open space/parklands.

Current population is approximately 300,000 predicted to increase to over 500,000 by 2041¹.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Growing Suburbs Fund will help the City of Casey upgrade and expand the existing Strathaird Family and Community Centre in Narre Warren South.

The project includes:

- Construction of an additional kindergarten room
- Construction of a Maternal and Child Health consulting room; and
- Expansion of the existing community space to include a kitchen and internet café facility.

These works will provide valuable improvements for families with young children in Narre Warren South, to better meet the needs of the growing number of young families in the area.

Expected completion: Mid 2019

Growing Suburbs Fund: \$1,400,000

Other Contributions: \$1,414,795
