PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Funding from the Growing Suburbs Fund will be used to revitalise and activate the space around the existing Wallaroo Reserve in Hastings.

The project will deliver a safer and better quality open space area with a focus on the needs of the community.

The project will deliver:

- Landscaping including native trees and gabions,
- Safety barriers; and
- Murals and totem poles

Expected completion: Late 2017
