The restrictions include indoor and outdoor public places. Unless you have a lawful reason not to wear one, face covering remain mandatory when indoors and outdoors – for example the supermarket or on public transport. You must continue to carry a face covering with you at all times.

Door knocking	YES	Doorknocking can occur, but you must not enter the person's home and must maintain physical distancing of 1 metres. Private gatherings are not permitted as detailed above. You should use common sense and consideration when it comes to interacting with people in public places such as shopping centres and railway stations and take safety precautions, including physical distancing. Unless you have a lawful reason not to wear one, the use of face coverings is required. You must carry a face covering with you at all times.
