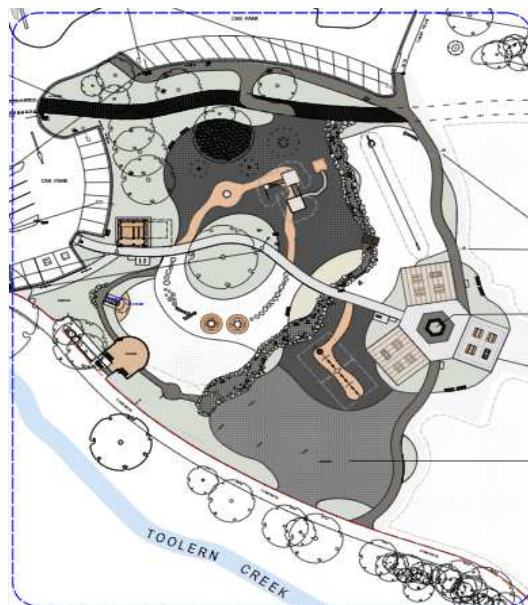


Figure 1: Hannah Watts Park Upgrade – Site Plan
