REOPENING ROADMAPS AND EASED RESTRICTIONS

The Victorian Government has released updated roadmaps and guidance in announcing the easing of restrictions for metropolitan Melbourne to the Second Step. You can read the [Statement from the Premier](#) here.

The updated roadmaps for metropolitan Melbourne and regional Victoria, as well as industry restrictions by region are available at: [Coronavirus \(COVID-19\) roadmap for reopening.](#) Metropolitan Melbourne moved to the Second Step towards COVID Normal from 11:59pm on 27 September. Key updates for local governments in metropolitan Melbourne include:

- outdoor pools can open subject to restrictions
- personal training can resume outdoors with a maximum of two people and their trainer
- childcare centres can re-open and permitted worker childcare permits are no longer required, this includes informal childcare arrangements
- standalone (sessional) kindergarten programs recommence from Monday 5 October in line with Term 4
- Transfer stations can reopen to the public for the purpose of disposing of organic waste and garden waste.
