STAGE 4 RESTRICTIONS – COUNCIL BUSINESS GUIDANCE

From 6 August 2020, 31 metropolitan Melbourne local government areas have been subject to Stage 4 restrictions to help slow the spread of coronavirus (COVID-19). Unless an exception applies, only Permitted Work Premises may operate in these areas.

As councils provide critical services to their communities, some services will be able to continue operating but others must be modified, reduced or temporarily suspended.

Local Government Victoria has worked with Business Victoria and the Department of Health and Human Services to provide guidance to councils on how restrictions affect different areas of your work:
