

# Growing Suburbs Fund

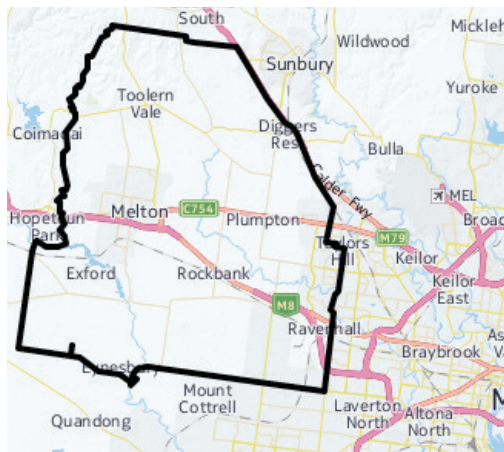

The City of Melton is located approximately 40 kilometres west of Melbourne and has been experiencing significant growth over the past decade with new suburban developments such as Caroline Springs and Hillside.

Melton is expected to continue strong residential growth with a number of new growth areas currently under development. It is anticipated that Melton's population will more than double between 2016 and 2036<sup>1</sup>.

### PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Growing Suburbs Fund will help Melton City Council deliver an extension to the existing Burnside Children's and Community Centre.

The extended space will include an additional 550 square metres of floor area, large multi-purpose activity areas, and the largest community meeting space in Melton East.
