PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Funding from the Growing Suburbs Fund will help Wyndham City Council activate Wyndham Park along the Werribee River. This will create an accessible recreational space for the Wyndham community.

The project will deliver:

- Active river trails including walking and cycling paths
- Event lawn to accommodate a wide range of activities
- River terraces; and
- Tables, seating and drinking fountains.
