## TERMS OF REFERENCE OF THE MUNCIPAL MONITOR APPOINTED UNDER

## **SECTION 223CA OF THE LOCAL GOVERNERMENT ACT 1989**

## TO MONITOR GOVERNANCE PROCESSES AND PRACTICES

## AT FRANKSTON CITY COUNCIL

Without limiting the municipal monitor's functions under section 223CB of the *Local Government Act* 1989 (Act), the municipal monitor is:

- To monitor the Frankston City Council's (Council) governance processes and practices, with specific regard to the key areas of concern identified by the Chief Municipal Inspector, including –
  - Council's meeting proceedings and decision making, and Councillor attendance at Council briefings and meetings;
  - Council's Councillor Code of Conduct, Councillor behaviour with respect to the Code of Conduct, Council's internal resolution procedure, and processes for resolving disputes between Councillors; and
  - c. The Chief Executive Officer's policies and practices that manage the interactions between Councillors and Council staff, and compliance with those policies and practices.
- 2. To advise on, and provide assistance and support, to the Council in relation to the Council's governance processes and practices, with specific regard to the matters raised in clause 1; and
- 3. To report to the Minister for Local Government on
  - a. Any steps taken by the Council to improve its governance and the effectiveness of those steps or actions, with specific reference to the matters raised in clause 1; and
  - b. Any recommendations for the exercise of the Minister's powers under the Act.
