### **PROJECT DESCRIPTION**

The Growing Suburbs Fund will help Mornington Peninsula Shire Council upgrade and expand the existing Oakridge Recreational Reserve in Mornington.

The project will deliver:

- Play equipment with a soft fall area
- An active play 'kick-a-bout' space
- Landscaping and pathways; and
- A nature reserve with walking tracks.
