### PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Growing Suburbs Fund will help upgrade and expand the Waterfall Gully Preschool that services Rosebud and surrounding townships.

The improvements include:

- A major upgrade to the main kitchen for children's cooking activities
- Refurbishment of the kitchenette
- Installation of art sinks for children
- Relocation and refurbishment of the children's toilets; and
- Upgrades to make the adult toilets accessible.
