### PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Werribee is a fast growing and diverse suburb, that will benefit from the new sporting, recreational and community facilities this project will provide.

The Chirnside Park Hub Redevelopment will create a fully accessible community facility catering for all abilities and genders. The redevelopment will include a grandstand, multi-use rooms, social, community and training spaces, commercial kitchen, meeting rooms, media rooms and coaches spaces, landscaping and car parking.

These facilities will be utilised for sporting, education, training and community programs to improve health and fitness, increase community participation, and reduce socio-economic disadvantage.
