# Growing Suburbs Fund 2021-22

The Growing Suburbs Fund is a contribution towards meeting critical local infrastructure needs for communities in Melbourne's diverse and fast-growing outer suburbs. It is positioned to quickly respond to the pressures being experienced by interface and peri-urban communities by bringing forward local infrastructure projects that will make a big difference in the day-to-day lives of outer suburban families.

Cardinia Shire Council is located on Melbourne's southeast fringe and is about 55 km from the Melbourne Central Business District.

Cardinia Shire Council is part of the interface council area and recorded a growth rate of 3.6% in 2019-20.1 The population is projected to grow from 116,193 in 2020 to about 177,868 or 53.1% per cent by 2036.<sup>2</sup>

Victoria's population has witnessed a considerable slow-down in growth due to COVID and a pause in overseas migration. This is mostly felt in the inner/middle suburbs of Melbourne but is still evident in outer suburbs.

### Main Street Pakenham Revitalisation

#### Main Street, Pakenham 3810

The Growing Suburbs Fund will assist Cardinia Shire Council to revitalise Main Street in Pakenham.

The Main Street Pakenham Revitalisation project is a first step as an upgrade to the Pakenham Activity Centre and will see the delivery of an improved streetscape and public realm with increased outdoor dining opportunities to assist in stronger social cohesion, and to provide a safe and vibrant space for community to shop, eat, relax, socialise, work and live.

This project will include:

- Straightening Main Street and creating consistent parking spaces to simplify traffic movement
- Increasing the width of the shared path to allow for more on-street trading and active transports
- Upgrading the stormwater infrastructure and introducing additional water sensitive urban design measures
- Increasing and improving the landscape and plantings
- Provisions of street furniture and supporting amenities to provide innovative and integrated shared spaces
- Continuous verandas and awnings to increase shade and weather protection.




Figure 1: Concept design
