EXTENSION OF TRUCK CURFEWS EXEMPTION

The Victorian Government has extended the removal of truck curfews to continue to support deliveries to Victorian pharmacies and supermarkets.

The truck curfew exemption has been extended and applies across the state up to 30 June 2022.

Greater flexibility is required in scheduling driver deliveries to meet high demand periods, which will mean deliveries outside of normal operating hours. This will assist supermarkets and pharmacies to meet sustained high demand of essential household goods.

The Government is urging councils to examine how they can continue to support the rapid replenishment of stock into supermarkets and pharmacies, including consideration of temporarily adjusting delivery restrictions.

As we continue to adjust to life with COVID-19, it is vital that every tier of government is working collectively and cooperatively.

The truck curfew exemption period will be reviewed and can be revoked before 30 June 2022 if warranted.
